Discrimination, the Key to Sani

In this series of articles, we have been talking about a disease that infects all humanists, atheists, agnostics, evolutionists, queers, College professors, and everyone in the NEA, ACLU, and Democartic Party: it is Bibliophobia. The thing that terrorizes all of the "New Age global citizens"—the unholy fear that grips their entire being and drives them up the wall—is that someone might read Genesis 1-3 out loud where others can hear it. Or even worse, they might read Jeremiah 23 or Matthew 23 or John 8 or 1 Corinthians 6. That's what "flips their lids." They are more afraid of a child or teenager in a public school classroom hearing or seeing Matthew 23:9 or 1 Timothy 2:5 than they are of hiring a queer with AIDS to babysit in a daycare center—LITER-ALLY. The rulings and guide-

This group of prejudiced bigots would rather have a Lesbian teach your child that his ancestors were lemurs, tarsiers, and apes, and that he came from a blob of protoplasm and is headed for a black hole, than expose him or her to John 3, 5, 8 or Romans 3, 5, 10 or 1 John 3, 4, 5. Their fear is not just irrational and silly, it is psychotic: they need help in a clinic.

Now for a moment, let us pretend that we Bible believers actually have the same rights under the Civil Rights Act that sex perverts, blacks, felons, women, and

Peter calls the sufferings of some Christians a "fiery trial." One hymn writer back in the Nineteenth Century wrote: "Some thru the waters. some thru the flood. Some thru the FIRE, but all thru the blood." There have been many times in church history when "the fiery trial" was literal fire. The Romans tried burning Polycarp at the stake (tradition says he had to be killed by the sword because he wouldn't catch fire; when the sword went through him. the blood that came out put out the flames). Nero used to take Christians and tie them to crosses; he would then have them smeared with tar and oil and set aflame to provide light for banquets in his gardens at night.

The Roman Catholic Church burned literally thousands of evangelical believers in the Dark Ages who were condemned as "witches." The Bohemian Reformer John Huss was burned at the stake, even though the Pope promised him safe passage to and from the Council of Constance.

When Mary Tudor ("Bloody Mary") took over the throne of England, she lit up the skies around Smithfield as she Continued on 3

The word "repent" occurs in the New Testament more than ten times as many as the word "regeneration." When John the Baptist showed up for the first time preaching, he said, "Repent" (Matt. 3:1-2). Christ's first sermon after being baptized was: "Repent" (Matt. 4:17). In the Gospels, the apostles "preached that men should repent" (Mark 6:12). At Pentecost. Peter told the Jews responsible for crucifying Jesus Christ: "Repent" (Acts 2:38, 3:19). The Apostle Paul preached "repentance" (Acts 20:21). Christ told those churches in Revelation 2:3 to "repent" (Rev. 2:5, 16, 21-22, 3:3, 19).

God commands repentance. "And the times of this ignorance God winked at: but now commandeth all men every where to repent" (Acts 17:30).

It is the burden of the heart of God that all should repent. "The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness: but is longsuffering to usward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance" (2 Pet. 3:9).

Failure to repent can lead to damnation, according to the Lord Jesus Christ. "I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ve shall all likewise perish" (Luke 13:3).

Repentance comes before believing the Gospel. Christ preached: "Repent ve" first. and then "believe the gospel" (Mark 1:15). Repentance

"Thy Kingdom Come

In the Scriptures, there are two main kingdoms: the Kingdom of God and the Kingdom of Heaven. While there are some things about these two kingdoms that are similar. they are definitely different kingdoms.

One is a *spiritual* kingdom that has *nothing* to do with politics, food, clothing, jobs, or "peace on earth." That's the Kingdom of God. It is a spiritual kingdom because: at all studying your Bible, "God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth" (John 4:24). Christ said that kingdom "is within **you**" (Luke 17:21), and that you enter it by the New Birth (John 3:3-7). It is defined in Romans 14:17 as having nothing to do with what you eat or what you drink since it is not a *material* kingdom; it is said to be "righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost."

When you deal with the Kingdom of Heaven, you're on other grounds and other "footings" entirely, for unlike God, the heavens are clearly visible (Psa. 19:1 cf. Col. 1:15; 1 Tim. 1:17; Heb. 11:27); you can look at them day or night. The Bible lists three of them (see 2 Cor. 12:2); the only one you can't see right now is "the third heaven" where the Lord's abode is, the center of His being (Rev. 21:2–3 cf. 4:1–6). To get to that heaven, you would have to pass through the *physical* universe (Eph. 4:10; Heb. 4:14). When you look up at the stars at night, you are seeing the second heaven (Gen. 1:14-17); when you watch birds flying in the sky, you are looking at the first heaven (Gen. 1:20).

The heavens are physical. The ground on which you are

in the *physical* heavens. The whole thing is visible and physical: there's not a spiritual thing in it anywhere. As such, it has no relationship to the Kingdom of God at all because it consists of meat. drink, trees, stones, mountains, stars, sand dunes, rivers, lakes, ponds, valleys, plateaus, clouds, rain, snow, fire, water, men, fish, insects, etc. It's a physical kingdom.

Now if you spend any time vou will learn rather quickly that there is *no* Kingdom of God on this earth between Genesis 3 and Acts 2. The spiritual kingdom starts when the Holy Spirit comes down to take Christ's place and indwell the bodies of believers as Jesus said (Luke 17:21). When the Lord Jesus taught the Jews to pray "Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven" (Matt. 6:10), He wasn't talking about the Holy Ghost spreading a *spiritual* kingdom by the New Birth and the preaching of the Gospel. Those are two physical kingdoms: one in Heaven and one on earth. The prayer was for the literal, physical, visible kingdom in Heaven to come down to earth. The so-called "Sermon on the Mount" is the constitution of that kingdom.

That is the kingdom those Jewish disciples had in mind when they asked Christ. "wilt thou at this time restore again the kingdom to Israel?" (Acts 1:6). They were talking about the physical kingdom covenanted to David in 2 Samuel 7.

"And when thy days be fulfilled, and thou shalt sleep with thy fathers, I will set up thy seed after thee, which shall proceed

in an physical solar system He shall build an house for my name, and I will stablish the throne of his kingdom FOR EVER And thine house and thy kingdom shall be established FOR EVER before thee: thy throne shall be established FOR EVER" (2 Sam. 7:12-13, 16).

> That's three times the Lord told David that his descendants would rule on a literal throne over a literal kingdom FOREVER. You say, "The Jews sinned. God threw them out of the land and got rid of their King (Jer. 22:28-30)."

> That's true, but it's completely irrelevant to the covenant God made with David. Look at Jeremiah 33:20-26. Same author, same book; and this is what the Lord said after what He said in Jeremiah 22.

"Thus saith the LORD: If ye can break my covenant of the day, and my covenant of the night, and that there should not be day and night in their season; Then may also my covenant be broken with David my servant, that he should not have a son to reign upon his throne; and with the Levites the priests, my ministers. As the host of heaven cannot be numbered, neither the sand of the sea measured: so will I multiply the seed of David my servant, and the Levites, that minister unto me Thus saith the LORD; If my covenant be not with day and night, and if I have not appointed the ordinances of heaven and earth; Then will I cast away the seed of Jacob. and David my servant, so that I will not take any of his seed to be rulers over the seed of Abraham. out of thy bowels, and I Isaac, and Jacob: for I standing is a physical planet will establish his kingdom. will cause their captivity

to return, and have mercy on them" (Jer. 33:20-22, 25-26).

After cutting off Jeconiah's seed from ever being King, and after throwing those Jews out of the Promised Land because of their sin, God said, "I'm going to bring those Jews back to the land. and I'm going to keep my covenant with David. His seed is going to rule over my people Israel, and that thing is just as sure as day and night."

God said He would bring those Jews back to the land a "second time" (Isa. 11:11), and He did. He said He would set a Son of David on David's throne in Jerusalem (Luke 1:32-33), and He will. It's prophecied over and over again in the Old Testament (Psa. 2; Isa. 2, 11, 60, 61, 62, 65, 66; Jer. 23, 33; Ezek. 37, 40-48; etc.).

That was the kingdom John the Baptist said was "at hand" when he showed up preaching repentance in Matthew 3:2—"the kingdom of heaven is at hand." That's the same kingdom Christ preached in Matthew 4:17— "the kingdom of heaven is at hand." Why? Because the King was right there.

That kingdom was post-Continued on 6


"The Fiery Trial

Continued from 1 burned such English Reformers as John Rogers, Hugh Latimer, Thomas Cranmer, and Nicholas Ridley. As Ridley was being chained to the stake, he said to his executioner, "Good fellow, knock heavy and hard (referring to the staple that held the chain to the stake). for the flesh will have its course!" He was burned along with Hugh Latimer, and when the faggots were lit, Latimer said to Ridley, "Be of good comfort, Mr. Ridley, and play the man! We shall this day light such a candle, by God's grace in England, as I trust shall never be put out.

When Peter talks about "the fiery trial," that's what he's talking about. Don't think that man has progressed up Darwin's ladder "from puddle to paradise" one inch since the Dark Ages. The same thing happens today in the right circumstances. Many converted Hindu pastors over in India have been burned alive in the last few years (2009-2011). As far back as 1999, a missionary named Graham Staines was burned alive in his car, along with his two sons, by Hindu radicals. That wasn't in the Dark Ages. That happened long after World War II, at the end of the Twentieth Century.

That is Simon Peter's "fiery trial"; it is applicable to any child of God in any century. Of course, if it doesn't happen, then thank God and serve Jesus Christ in freedom and peace while you have a chance, but realize that that is not the "norm" for the Christian life. It is abnormal: it is the exception to the rule. The rule is: "all that live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution" (2 Tim. 3:12).

Nobody makes it through this life without trouble. Some troubles are pretty bad and some are terrible. One of our



Gipp, broke his neck while he was down here in school, and the doctors didn't diagnose his problem correctly. As a result, Bro. Gipp has suffered with pain every day of his life since, which at the time of this writing has been nearly 31 years.

There used to be a guy over at my church at Brent named Don Baker. Back in the 60s, he was driving one of those little compact cars and was in an accident. The car flipped over on him, and he ended up paralyzed and in a wheelchair for the rest of his life. He had very little funds to take care of his wife and two young boys. Those teenage boys had to go to work to support their family while other young men were playing sports, dating, and running around having a good time.

Over at the Brent Baptist Church there was a family named Shell. They lost their teenage boy in a horrible car wreck. The body of that boy was so badly mangled that his funeral had to be "closed coffin." Brethren, there are some people in this world who have some real problems, did you know that? Christians aren't exempt.

When these trials and tribulations come your way, don't be shocked. The tendency will be to walk around in a graduates, Evangelist Sam daze, wondering what happened to you. The Lord may show you why it happened, and then again. He may not. The "why" is not the important thing. What is important in a situation like that is how you react to it.

You might say, "Oh, I would never blame God; the Devil is doing this to me." That may be


partly true, but remember, the Devil can't do anything to you unless God gives him permission (Job 1-2).

When Satan comes after you, God is letting him do it for a *reason*. When "time and chance" happen to a Christian (Eccl. 9:11), it is the Lord who allows those things to go on so He can accomplish His purposes. I am not too strong of a Calvinist or a fatalist in these matters. I don't think God causes everything that happens to you, but I do think He allows everything. When He does, the Lord has a reason. There is no such thing as "luck" or "chance" or "accident" with the born-again child of God.

Our job is to get close to Christ. If we need to get right about something, we should get right. If we need to sur-

as rain"!



Continued from 1 comes before forgiveness: the Gospel message is "repentance" first, and then "remission of sins should be preached in his name yourself." among all nations" (Luke 24:47).

God's goodness leads a sinner to repentance (Rom. 2:4). Repentance brings mercy and pardon from God (Isa. 55:7). Heaven rejoices when a sinner repents (Luke 15:7). And if the Lord didn't love you, He wouldn't tell you to repent (Rev. 3:19).

It's amazing that with such an emphasis laid on the doctrine, that you don't hear preachers preaching much about it. When was the last time you heard a preacher preach on repentance to any TV or radio audience, or to any big church congregation?

If you want to know what repentance is *not*, just check out the following list of subjects, preached all the time to

modern congregations, which lead YOURSELF. They major have absolutely nothing to do with repentance.

- 1. "Sharing Christ's love."
- 2. Learning to "live with
- 3. Resolving conflict, stress, and "tensions."
- 4. "Reaching out and touching others.'
 - 5. Having faith in yourself.
 - 6. "Coping" with others.
- 7. "Realizing your poten-
 - 8. "Promise keeping."
- 9. Changing your "lifestyle."
- 10. Getting a "purposedriven life."
- 11. Banishing all negative thoughts.
- 12. Feeling good about yourself.

None of that is repentance; it is amateur psychology. Those are not even Bible subjects. All twelve of those things teach you to think about YOURSELF, talk about YOURSELF, and guide and in self analysis, self-respect, and self-love.

All those things are on how to win and make friends of egomaniacs who think about themselves 24 hours a day. All those types of sermons do is teach Christians how to deny the cross and fall in love with themselves. American churches are stuffed full of them.

Well, then, if all that psychological drivel is not repentance, what is it? Basically, repentance means "to turn from" or having a change of heart, mind, or attitude about something. That's what the Bible means when you read about God repenting of something (see Gen. 6:6; Jon. 3:10). When Moses tells God to "repent" in Exodus 32:12, he's not telling the Lord to turn from His sin; he's telling Him to change His mind about what He was about to do to the children of Israel.

Of course, there are some things of which God will never repent because they are fixed (Num. 23:19). When God swears by Himself (see Heb. 6:13), there is no "shadow of turning" on the subject (cf. James 1:17). But there are many things in the Scriptures where God will change His mind about a thing depending on whether man repents or not (e.g., see Jer. 22:3-5).

Evangelical" repentance (i.e., Gospel repentance) is turning from sin and to God. It is not merely sorrow for sin. Paul wrote to the Corinthians:

"Now I rejoice, not that ye were made sorry, but that ye sorrowed to repentance: for ye were made sorry after a godly manner . . . For godly sorrow worketh repentance to salvation not to be repented of: but the sorrow of the world worketh death" (2 Cor. 7:9-10).

A Critique Of

The New International Version

The latest Athenian gimmick for those who want "to tell, or to hear some new thing" (Acts 17:21) is the NV, an Alexandrian publication that lines up with the Jesuit, Rheims, Dark Age, Catholic Bible of 1582. Naturally the Roman Catholic Soviets have approved of it and will "go along" with its printing, provided it includes the seven spurious Alexandrian books known as The Apocrypha.

The reason for the success of this apostate trash is clear. It used the catch word "INTERNATIONAL," which is the Communist nomenclature these days for "all getting together." Nationalism is out. Hence the word "American" (ASV. MASV) can't quite "out the mustard," (as they said back in the fifties). "International" has an aura of Popes, Politburo, CFR, United Nations, and the "brotherhood of man" about it that sells good these days. Although the MIV is still short of about 300,000,000 cales to match the AV (closer to 500,000,000), it has in recent years been able to keep up with contemporary AV sales. To match the AV the NIV will have to distribute 809,000,000 copies, which it certainly will not do, even with the backing of fifty thousand scholars, a thousand universities, good press, publicity stunts, and the Roman Curia. Why does the child of God reject this corrupt translation? Well, there are a number of excellent reasons, and three of them are absolutely final. To begin with, the translation makes a liar out of God in three places. I called this to the attention of the head of the translating committee in a debase in Fort Myers, Florida, in the winter of 1987. He had no answer, Toboluttal, and refused to even discuss the verses.

They are Mark 1:2, Matthew \$2.22, and Luke 23.42. In the first instance, Isaind id NOT give the quotation, as the NIV falsely claims: it is from Malachi. In the second instance, Christ was never in danger of

Continued from 2 poned in Matthew 13 and put into mystery form ("the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven"—Matt. 13:11) because those Jews wouldn't receive their King (John 1:11 cf. Matt. 13:14-15). The leaders of the nation flatly rejected that kingdom in Acts 7.

Because of that, the Lord told them this: "the kingdom of GOD [get that; it's the spiritual kingdom, not the physical one] shall be taken from you, and given to a nation bringing forth the fruits thereof" (Matt. 21:43). Immediately, two religious groups popped up pretending that when God put Israel "on the shelf," that He chose them to take its place. Both of them claimed to be religions and political States at the same time. They were both theocracies. like Israel: Church-States.

The first was the Vatican State, which claimed its church, the Roman Catholic Church, got all the promises made to Israel in the Old Testament in a spiritual fashion instead of a physical one. All the Popes claim they got the spiritual Kingdom of God, but of course, what the Vatican set up was a political State which has been involved in international politics for over fourteen centuries. It deals with nothing but "meat and drink" (cf. Rom. 14:17) every Sunday morning at 11:00. It's whole purpose is to replace the Jewish theocracy of the Old Testament with a Roman Catholic theocracy found nowhere in the New Testament.

The Roman Catholic Church created a kingdom that has nothing to do with the Kingdom of God at all. As a matter of fact, throughout its history, the Catholic Church has been responsible for murdering thousands of saved people who had been Christ" (Rev. 11:15), and baptized by the Holy Ghost into the Body of Christ (1 Cor. 12:13). It is the "Holy Ghost" who deals with the spiritual "kingdom of God" (Rom. 14:17), not the physical Kingdom of Heaven.

There is no physical Kingdom of Heaven from Acts 7 to Revelation 19. That kingdom only comes when "the kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his



The Great Plumbline

As this age comes to a conclusion and the UN prepares to receive the Antichrist as the world's ruler, the religious picture gets more confused by the minute until, at last, it is simply unintelligible. A "plumbline" is a string with a "plumbbob" (a teardropped piece of metal) at the end with the tip of the metal pointing down. It is still used by all masons and carpenters. The idea behind it is very simple: you cannot build anything straight *vertically* unless you begin at the *top*. I had better say that again so you'll get the point: "you cannot build anything *straight* vertically unless you begin at the TOP. That means you can never go the

strait way up to Heaven (see Matt. 7:13–14) by beginning at the *bottom* and climbing up.

Throwing a plumbbob into the air with a plumbline attached to it and trying to build even with the line before it falls to the ground is like trying to get to Heaven by taking the sacraments, observing Ramadan, living by the Golden Rule, praying five times a day and reciting the Shahada, etc. All religions begin at the ground level and work up; that's why none of them will ever get you to Heaven. That would be Buddhism, Taoism, Confucianism, Hinduism, Mohammedanism. Judaism. and Catholic, Greek Orthodox, and Protestant "Christianity."



Continued from 5 weeps over his sin but never gets right. Judas "repented" and said, "I have sinned" (Matt. 27:3-4), and he went to the Bottomless Pit (Act 1:25). Balaam repented of his sin and confessed, "I have sinned," and he went to Hell (Jude 11-13). King Saul said, "I have sinned," and the Lord rejected him, and he wound up in Hell (1 Sam. 15:23-24, 28:16). Pharaoh confessed, "I have sinned," and asked for prayer (Exod. 9:27-28), and he died and went to Hell (Rom. 9:17, 22).

Evangelical repentance is not sorrow for what you have done: it is sorrow for what you are. This is clearly demonstrated in the Scriptures in the cases of Simon Peter. Job. and Isaiah. After seeing the power of God in the miracle of the draught of fishes, Peter falls down before Jesus and says, "Depart from me; for I am a sinful man. O Lord" (Luke 5:8). His sorrow over his sinful state brought mercy and acceptance from Christ (Luke 5:10). When Job had a head-on collision with Deity, he didn't say, "I am so sorry I made a mistake and said the wrong thing"; he said, "I abhor myself and repent in dust and ashes" (Job 42:6). When he did that, the Lord restored him two-fold what he had lost (Job 42:10). Isaiah's sins were

taken away when he said, "I am a man of unclean lips" (Isa. 6:5–7). You don't read one word in that passage of him confessing any specific sin; he's bemoaning his *sinful state*.

"Doing penance" is not repentance, for it gives the sinner some merit to earn in order to gain salvation or forgiveness, and it often hinders true repentance. In the New Testament, it's "works meet for repentance" (Acts 26:20); that is, it's works that match the profession. It's not works done in order to gain salvation or forgiveness (Eph. 2:8–10; Tit. 3:5).

Evangelical repentance is

turning away from your sin and coming to God for forgiveness and restoration. Paul preached to the Gentiles in order "to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive the forgiveness of sins" (Acts 26:18). He said about his converts in Thessalonica that they "turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God" (1 Thess. 1:9).

Repentance has to be in the way God prescribed, or else it does you no good. In 2 Timothy 2:25, we read: "if God peradventure will give them repentance to the ac-



Continued from 3 render about a matter, we should surrender. It may be the Lord is trying to make sure we will get rewards in Heaven; we may be suffering as an example for others. I don't have all the answers to these things. What I can say for sure is that when the "fiery trial" comes, we need to be walking and talking with the "Fourth Man" in the fire (Dan. 3:25). The new "Bibles" change that verse so you will not look for Him when you go through "the fiery trial."

The problem is that in 1 Peter 4:13, Simon Peter says you are to "rejoice" when you go through "the fiery trial." That's the hard part. Some of us (and I include myself here) can take *some* suffering. Of course, we take it grimly, with a grimace on our face and our teeth clenched. But taking it with a *smile* and *rejoicing*. well, that's another story, isn't it? If we are taking reproach for the sake of our Saviour, then we should be "happy," and according to that Bible, we can be "happy" (1 Pet. 4:14). But of course, doing it is something else!

I used to visit a woman in the nursing home named Mrs. Salter. She was bedridden for 25 years. I never saw that lady when she didn't have the victory. I would go into her room, and she would always vell, "Well, hello, Bro. Pete!" I would ask her, "Mrs. Salter, do you have the victory? Let me hear you say, 'Praise the Lord." That sister would yell out, "Praise the Lord!" She said it louder than most Christians I've known who are in good health, sitting in a padded pew in an air-conditioned church.

I am not going to judge any Christian who is in constant pain. As I write this, I know a Christian in such terrible pain that if he committed suicide tomorrow. I wouldn't sav anvthing about it—not a word. I who might "cave in" under that and happiness, though, are man's circumstances. I don't think I could take some of the things through which some of my brethren ao. I will tell vou this, though: the Lord can get you through whatever circumstance you are in.



Biblical salvation is the only so-called "religion" in the world that comes down from the top. When God gave the instructions for building the Tabernacle, He began with Himself at the Ark of the Covenant and worked His way out to the sinner at the Brazen Altar (Exod.) 25:10). All the other religions stand in the mud of this sincursed world cracking their skulls by throwing the plumbbob into the air.

The Lord said. "I'll set a plumbline in the midst of the people; you ain't gonna do nuthin'." And that shows you what very few people in this world notice: Biblical Christianity is the only religion on the face of this earth where you deal with a person instead of the religion itself.

Religions are what sinners do to try to earn righteousness in order to get to the "Happy Hunting Ground" or Valhalla or Paradise or Heaven or wherever they are trying to go when they die. Biblical Christianity is what somebody has done for the sinner to get him to Heaven. Biblical Christianity begins at the top with God.

Salvation begins at the throne of God and works its way down (see Exod. 25:10). If you could reverse the procedure and try working your way up from the bottom, you would be thrown out of Heaven bodily by force (see Matt. 22:13) for being a THIEF.

The greatest "plumbline" God ever placed down on this earth was a man (1 Tim. 2:5). He said, "I am the door ... I am the good shepherd" (John 10:7-14). He said He was "the way" to get to the

top (John 14:6). When the Plumbline showed up (Mal. 3:3), He settled forever the question about man's goodness and all his religions (John 15:22). To build even with that Plumbline, you would have to be sinless (Heb. 4:15), and you're not.

It's very easy to spot the Plumbline; He begins at the top with God and comes down to the sinner.

"My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand" (John 10:27-28).

He's the one who owns the sheep; He's the one who keeps the sheep. It's all about Him, not the sheep. Eternal life is a free gift from Him, just as you find it in the Pauline Epistles (Rom. 6:23 cf. Eph. 2:8-9; Tit. 3:5).

Notice that the promise is that His sheep will "never perish," even though every Roman Catholic creed before and after Vatican II says they can. The passage says, "they shall never perish," even though the Greek Orthodox, the Episcopalians, the Methodists, and the Charismatics said they could.

Continued from 10 Rapture or by death), so we should get in practice rejoicing *right now.*

The Holy Bible says, "Yet if any man suffer as a Christian, let him not be ashamed; but let him GLO-RIFY God on this behalf" (1 Pet. 4:16). The words "glory" and "glorified" popped up back in 1 Peter 4:13-14 as well. The idea is that a child of God should be able to rejoice and glorify God in his sufferings because he is looking for God's "glory" to be "revealed" in his situation (1 Pet. 4:13). According to what the Book says, a Christian is able to thank God and rejoice for great suffering.

"Rejoice evermore. Pray without ceasing. In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you" (1 Thess. 5:16–18).

I wouldn't think of saying that's easy to do. *It wouldn't be.* But the Christian is able to do it through the Holy Spirit, nevertheless (Eph. 6:18; Phil. 4:6).

In 1 Peter 4:16, we are told to "glorify God" when we suffer for the right reason. The glory of God is directly connected with our suffering for the sake of the Lord Jesus Christ, who Himself was "a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief" (Isa. 53:3).

There is nothing in the New Testament that promises a "rosy future" for any Christian in America if the Lord tarries. In the Church-States that the Moslems have put up by forcing Islam on local governments through whining, complaining, demonstrating, bribery, corruption, and killing (all the while professing to be a "religion of peace"), the fiery trials have already taken place. If you listed all the Christian ministers and laymen whom the Moslems

have murdered in the Sudan, Iraq, Iran, Indonesia, Malaysia, Saudi Arabia, Turkey, Morocco, Algeria, Mauritania, Ethiopia, Nigeria, Egypt, Angola, etc., since 1940, it would come to well over 50,000. There are ten times as many "on deck" if Obama has his way. According to one of his schoolmates who was a Moslem, Obama's desire while he is President is to *unite the Islamic nations*.



There is a great deal of difference between real repentance based on the Pauline Gospel of 1 Corinthians 15:3-4 and the Catholic, Campbellite repentance based on the Messianic message to Israel in Acts 2:38. In Acts 2, Peter is telling the nation of Israel (Acts 2:5, 14) to repent of their sin of rejecting their Messiah (Acts 2:22-23). He didn't say one word about a sinner repenting of the sins he had committed that were driving him to Hell without the righteousness of Christ's finished atonement. There is not one word in Peter's Acts 2 message about Jesus Christ dying for anyone's sins, and that is part of the New Testament Gospel as defined by the Apostle to the Gentiles (1 Cor. 15:3).

These "Water Dogs" who repent and are "BUPtized" for the forgiveness of sins don't repent "to the acknowledging of the truth." When Peter preached to the Gentiles for the first time in Acts 10, he was all ready to pull his Jewish formula from Acts 2 on Cornelius when the Lord interrupted him and showed that Acts 2:38 was no longer the way to receive the Holy Spirit (Act 10:44-45). In Acts 2, Simon Peter went by what he knew at the time, and that was right; but in Acts 10, God gave him additional information. God changed the message. "The truth" (2 Tim. 2:25) after Acts 10 is

"repentance toward God, and FAITH TOWARD OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST" (Acts 20:21). If a preacher tells you to "repent, believe, confess, and be BUPtized" to be saved, mark it down, that is an unsaved "elder" trying to drag you down to Hell with himself, and he's using water to do it.

You receive forgiveness of sins through repentance and faith in Jesus' name (Acts 20:21, 10:43; Luke 24:47). Repentance is the work of the Holy Spirit who convicts of sin, righteousness, and judgment (John 16:8); and you "receive the promise of the Spirit through FAITH" (Gal. 3:14), not water baptism.

Moreover, repentance does not stop upon salvation. The command of God is that "ALL MEN EVERYWHERE" are "to repent" (Acts 17:30). Nobody is exempt, saved or lost. Of course, a Christian no longer has to repent for salvation, but he does have to repent to maintain fellowship with his Saviour. The Pauline Epistles are filled with commands for the believer to turn from his sins and do right to serve God (e.g., Eph. 4:21-32).

Repentance is negative; it means "quit it." Quit what? Quit your devilment; quit your meanness; quit your wickedness. Repent of your laziness in studying the word of God;



THE CREED OF

1. There is no final authority but God.

2. Since God is a Spirit, there is no final authority that can be seen, heard, read, felt, or handled.

3. Since all books are material, there is no book on this earth that is the final and absolute authority on what is right and what is wrong, what constitutes truth and what constitutes error.

4. There **WAS** a series of writings one time which, **IF** they had all been put into a BOOK as soon as they were written the first time, WOULD HAVE constituted an infallible and final authority by which to judge truth and error.

5. However, this series of writings was lost, and the God who inspired them was unable to preserve their content through Bible-believing Christians at Antioch (Syria), where the first Bible teachers were (Acts 13:1), and where the first missionary trip originated (Acts 13:1-52), and where the word "Christian" originated (Acts 11:26).

6. So God chose to ALMOST preserve them through Gnostics and philosophers from Alexandria, Egypt, even though God called His Son OUT of Egypt (Matthew 2), Jacob OUT of Egypt (Genesis 49), Israel OUT of Egypt (Exodus 15), and Joseph's bones OUT of Egypt (Exodus 13).

7. So there are two streams of Bibles. The most accurate—though, of course, there is no final, absolute authority for determining truth and error; it is a matter of "preference"—are the Egyptian translations from Alexandria, Egypt, which are "almost the originals," although

8. The most inaccurate translations were those that brought about the German Reformation (Luther, Zwingli, Boehler, Zinzendorf, Spener, et al.) and the worldwide missionary movement of the English-speaking people: the Bible that Sunday, Torrey, Moody, Finney,

Spurgeon, Whitefield, Wesley, and Chapman used.

9. But we can "tolerate" these if those who believe in them will "tolerate" US. After all, since there is NO ABSOLUTE AND FINAL **AUTHORITY** that anyone can read, teach, preach, or handle, the whole thing is a matter of "PREFERENCE." You may prefer what you prefer, and we will prefer what we prefer. Let us live in peace, and if we cannot agree on anything or everything, let us all agree on one thing: THERE IS NO FINAL, ABSOLUTE, WRITTEN AUTHORITY OF GOD ANYWHERE ON THIS EARTH.

The Great Plumbline

Continued from 12 reprobates in those religions considered Peter a liar (1 Pet. 1:4-5), Paul a liar (2 Tim. 1:12), and *John* a liar (1 John 5:13).

The official doctrinal beliefs of the Roman Catholic Church from A.D. 325-2012 exhibit this rejection of God's Plumbline. No Catholic saint (like Mother Teresa or anyone like her) knew for certain where they were going when they died; and no Catholic Monk, Nun, Cardinal, Bishop, Archbishop, Priest, or Pope had assurance of salvation. None of them knew what Peter. John. or Paul knew about God's Plumbline.

The Apostle to the Gentiles (Rom. 11:13), when writing to the Pope's "flock" (Rom. 1:7—the Pope is supposed to be the "Bishop of Rome"), said that every one of them would end up just like his Saviour.

"For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be CONFORMED TO THE IMAGE OF HIS SON" (Rom. 8:29).

According to the open, public confession of the Knights of Columbus, not one Roman Catholic through 1,686 years of church history believed the Holy Scriptures as any "early Christian" believed them. I just read you what the "early Christians" believed. Folks, the "early Christians" are in the book of Acts and in the Pauline and General Epistles: they aren't the "Church Fathers" who professed to believe God's Plumbline when they rejected the Bible, corrected the Bible, allegorized away the Bible, and replaced the Bible with stale, warmedover Greek philosophy. Finally, my buddy made her read Romans 8:29 out loud. That woman gave a loud in-suck of air and then practically yelled, "Oh, I wish he hadn't said that!" So do the Pharisees, the Popes, and the Moslems.

Another of my ministerial buddies was preaching a revival meeting, and a Nazarene came in there and planted himself down in the "amen

Polycarp, Irenaeus, and Justin corner" and lustily "amened" every point. My friend's sermon was "Come See a Man" from John 4:29.

> He came down through there with "Come see a Healer," and that Nazarene shouted. "Amen!" "Come see a Captain"—"Amen! Halleluiah! Glory to God!" "Come see a Shepherd"-"Amen! That's Him! He's the Good Shepherd! Glorveee!"

> And then my preacher friend finished up with: "Come see the One who gives His sheep eternal life and never lost a one of them (John 10:28, 17:12)." That did it! He didn't get a holy grunt out of that shouting Nazarene. It was like a dark cloud had passed across that quy's face. At heart, when it came to the "Plumbline," that Nazarene was just like Mohammed and all the "Holy Fathers" in Rome back to A.D. 325.
