## The Boss— The King James 1611

Along time ago, when I was a young teenaged boy, we called something we thought was cool or was better than the rest, "Boss". We had no idea where it came from, but it was "Boss". Young people have always had a slang language that the older folks don't get, and it is no different today. Not many months ago, a young man told me that something was "wicked good".

I later asked my class if that term meant it was good or bad, and they gave me the look that my Dad used to give me when I said something was "Boss". The young men told me that it meant something was really good. All I could do was give them Isaiah 5:20, which says, "**Woe to them that call evil good, and good evil; that put darkness for light, and light for darkness...**". They looked at me like I just ruined their slang, and maybe they needed to find another term.

Though it has been over fifty years that have passed since I used the

term "Boss", I am back to using it. The KJV1611 is just "Boss". This present evil world, with a hatred for that precious Book, must still march to the tune that the Boss plays. Though they are under the "**god of this world**" (2 Cor. 4:4), they (and their "god") must follow the prophecy that the Boss has laid down for them to follow. Even as they think that they are just doing their own thing, this lost world is bowing to what the Boss told them would happen in these last days.

As an example, in the prophecy of Joel 3:2-4, the Boss says that the nations will part the Lord's land (Israel), and then tells them exactly what they would call this new land after they parted it, calling it "Palestine" (verse 4). EVERY corrupt version in print today (NIV, ASV, NASV, NEW JERUSALEM, NKJV, etc.) calls the new land "Philistia" or the "land of Philistines". In 1969, a man named Arafat came to power in the Arab world and was named Chairman of the PLO. Why did he call it the "Palestinian Liberation Organization", and not the Philistine Liberation Organization? Simply because the Boss (and only the KJV)

# Desertion and Discharge

Life is a warfare. After he finished his ministry, Paul said, **“I have fought a good fight...”** (2 Tim. 4:7).

He told Timothy, **“This charge I commit unto thee, son Timothy, according to the prophecies which went before on thee, that thou by them mightest war a good warfare”** (1 Tim. 1:18).

In another place, he says, **“Thou therefore endure hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ”** (2 Tim. 2:3).

It's a warfare, and I'm not talking about battling against the brethren. I'm talking about fighting against the world, the flesh, and the devil. I'm talking about being in a consistent, lifelong warfare against the world system, against your own sins, against the flesh.

**“There is no man that hath power over the spirit to retain the spirit; neither hath he power in the day of death: and there is no discharge in that war; neither shall wickedness deliver those that are given to it”** (Ecc. 8:8).

It's like dying in warfare. You hear people saying, “I've got cancer, but I'm going to beat it—I'm going to win the battle!”. They never do. They always die. In plainer words, when your time is up, your time is up, there is no discharge. If the Lord comes, we get out of it, but there is no discharge.

Sometimes you can get a discharge because of medals, valor in action, longevity, or a medical discharge. There are all kinds of ways

you can get discharges, but there is no discharge when it comes to death.

In Judges 7, Gideon is about to go out to battle. **“And the LORD said unto Gideon, The people that are with thee are too many for me to give the Midianites into their hands, lest Israel vaunt themselves against me, saying, Mine own hand hath saved me. Now therefore go to, proclaim in the ears of the people, saying, Whosoever is fearful and afraid, let him return and depart early from mount Gilead. And there returned of the people twenty and two thousand; and there remained ten thousand”** (Judg. 7:2,3).

Let the cowards go if they want to. Let him get out because if he sticks around, he'll demoralize the rest. Twice as many people left as stayed—he lost two-thirds of his army in one crack!

**“So he brought down the people unto the water: and the LORD said unto Gideon, Every one that lapped of the water with his tongue, as a dog lappeth, him shalt thou set by himself; likewise every one that boweth down upon his knees to drink. And the number of them that lapped, putting their hand to their mouth, were three hundred men: but all the rest of the people bowed down upon their knees to drink water. And the LORD said unto Gideon, By the three hundred men that lapped will I save you...”**

(Judg. 7:5-7).

You talk about decimating the troops! That guy starts out with thirty-two thousand troops, and he winds up with three hundred! He is down one man out of a hundred before he gets through. Now what he is talking about in selecting this army is this; If a guy gets down and sticks his head in the water, then he can go home. But if he laps like a dog out of his hand, then keep him. Isn't that a strange IQ test? There is more to this than you think. You are going to see it here in a minute.

There has to be morale among the troops. That means they have to believe in what they are doing—they have convictions about it, and they are going to throw themselves into it.

Now the first lesson we learn from this passage is in verse 7. In any Christian work, the faithful ones will always be the minority. Gideon ended up with one out of one hundred men.

Enoch was in the minority—he was a two-man minority. Enoch and Noah were the only two men that got along in his day. Jeremiah was a minority. He only had two buddies—Baruch and Ebedmelech. Those three stood against the whole nation of Israel. Against all the priests, all the elders, and all the kings. It's *always* a minority that is faithful.

I have only three autographs in my house. I don't hunt autographs, but I have an autograph by a hockey player named Red Berenson from the St. Louis Blues. Somebody else wrote and got that for me. The only two

other autographs I have are those of Harlan Popov and Josef "Pips" Priller. Pips Priller was a German Luftwaffe pilot in WWII. Harlan Popov was a prisoner in Bulgaria in a concentration camp off and on for 13 years. Those fellows are a minority. Popov was against the whole nation, and Pips Priller flew against thirteen thousand aircraft on Normandy Beach.

Who does the praying in your church? A minority. Who does the giving? Who does the witnessing? Boy, in most churches, it won't be a majority. There will be a handful here and a handful there.

The next lesson we learn from the passage is that in Christian work, many begin, but they don't finish.

**"...And there returned of the people twenty and two thousand; and there remained ten thousand"** (Judg. 7:3).

Now, what's the trouble? Well, many leave because the fight is different than they expected. They're not ready for it. When you come to PBI, I throw all the obstacles in your face that I possibly can and try to discourage you from entering the ministry. By telling you all the horrible, terrible things that can and will happen, I do my best to make you quit. And the reason why is when you get out there, I don't want you to get surprised.

Now that's the way combat training is. The best thing you can do with combat training is to persecute the guy and just make his life miserable—torment him day and night until he is ready to drop. That's the best

way to do it because when you get into combat, you'll take it in stride.

**“These things have I spoken unto you, that ye should not be offended. They shall put you out of the synagogues: yea, the time cometh, that whosoever killeth you will think that he doeth God service...But these things have I told you, that when the time shall come, ye may remember that I told you of them...”** (John 16:1-4).

I'm telling you right now, so when it comes around, you can say, “Well, here she comes.” That's the idea behind it. It's one thing to go down Pennsylvania Avenue in full stride with white gloves, polished boots, with the regimental colors waving and the band playing. There's a big difference between that, and getting out on a hill at 102 degrees with nothing to eat for a couple of days. Then running out of ammo and finding out the supply depot was blown up, and there isn't much coming in. Then at night, you are freezing so bad that you can hardly breathe. That is a different kind of a thing!

In 1861, when the Civil War started, the Yankee army marched around Pennsylvania Avenue in their beautiful new uniforms. They went down right into the First Battle of Bull Run, and they ran! They ran all the way back to Washington, and if the Southerners had had the experience (which they didn't have, it was a baptism of blood for both outfits) and would have counter-attacked, the war would have been over with the

first battle. But the Southerners got chewed up too, and they withdrew, and it went on for four more years. Women went out there dressed up, taking a picnic with them to watch the battle. The battlefield isn't a picnic!

In 1914, the French went to battle in taxicabs. They thought they would go out and meet the Germans in the Marne, and it would all be over in a couple of weeks. It went on for four more years.

The trouble is, in Christian service, some people hang around for the loaves and the fishes. Some people hang around just to get what they can. That's what they're there for, and the first time they don't get what they want—they're gone. They get the wrong idea about combat.

There was a fellow in my church one time; he did real fine until he found out that he couldn't run the church, so he headed off. There was a fellow who got in church, and he was going to do a great job. His fiancé was asked to do the church bulletin, and that took up time he wanted to spend with her. So, he got in an argument about church bulletins not being scriptural and prayer altars not being scriptural, and off he went. He hasn't led a soul to Christ now in fifty years,

There was family here that did well until they got in with the upper crust crowd, and off they went. I met her in the grocery store after I hadn't seen her for fifteen years. The family had broken up.

A fellow came down to go to school

on fire for God (I could name twenty of them like this). Then things went wrong, and he never came back. I could write a book on that stuff!

When they get in where the action is, and things start crossing them, then they get their feelings hurt. They get sullen, and they get sulking, and then they leave.

General Patton said, "Cowardice is epidemic." That is when one man throws down his gun and runs; anyone who sees him will be tempted to do the same thing. And if you see five of them go by you without their weapons, you are going to be tempted to throw off your helmet and run for your life. Once they get going like that, it isn't just a retreat—it's a rout. The thing can be a debacle, and that happens in Christian work.

The next lesson before us is in verse four. Your faith is going to be tested (**"bring them down unto the water, and I will try them for thee there"**). They are put to the test.

Things will test you in the Christian service, like sickness or betrayal of friends—sometimes your own family, poverty, persecution, or ridicule. They will try you out and see if you can stand. If you don't have real faith in the word of God, and close fellowship with Jesus Christ, in the day of battle, you'll run. You'll be out someplace protecting yourself.

Major General Alan W. Jones lost his reputation and everything else in an action in WWII of the 106<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division called "The Golden Lions". It happened on the Schnee Eifel pla-

teau. In that battle, he lost something like 8,000 men; almost 7,000 were captured. What happened there? He ran into the wrong outfit. He ran into Germans that had been fighting then for four years. They came through, and the 106<sup>th</sup> Division just came apart. They had no cohesion; they were green drafts, fresh from America. A German comment on it said, "...they had little spirit for fighting. Most of them often said, 'What do they want here, at home, we can get everything much better.'"

That's what happens in Christian combat. Christians find out that it's going to be too tough and too hard, and they can't take it. They get out of the combat and quit the fight.

Back in the Napoleonic Wars, during the Peninsular War that went down into Spain, there was a battle called the Battle of Albuera. French Marshal Soult wrote, "There is no beating these troops. They were completely beaten, the day was mine and they did not know it and would not run." Lieutenant Colonel William Inglis of the 57<sup>th</sup> Regiment was wounded. As he was dying, he was yelling at his men, "Die hard 57<sup>th</sup>, die hard!" Amen!

Paul said, **"Thou therefore endure hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ"** (1 Tim. 2:3).

I'll tell you another lesson we learn from this passage. The work, the real hard part, is going to be done by faithful men.

He said, **"Whosoever is fearful and afraid, let him return and**

**depart early**" (Judg. 7:3). We don't need him. Why? If he's not going to take orders, we don't need him. That would just be dangerous to the troops. There would be a "mixed multitude" like the Jews had coming out of Egypt.

In 1944, German troops under the SS officer Skorzeny (the fellow who rescued Mussolini) infiltrated our lines in France. They trained these guys to know everything an American was to know so they could pass off as American troops. The Americans found the best way to catch them was, instead of asking for passwords, the guard would ask, "Who's Li'l Abner's girlfriend?" or "give me a candy bar named after a baseball player?". The Germans couldn't run all that down.

One guy stopped a general and asked, "What's the capital of Arkansas?". The general said, "You fool, I've got to get by! I'm a general. Do you see these stars?". The fellow said, "Tell me what the capital of Arkansas is, or you ain't getting by." The general said, "You fool—I'm from Arkansas!" He didn't know the capital! Sometimes you could spot the Germans like that.

One time, some GI's came up to get some gas in the Jeep. The fellow asked for petrol instead of gasoline. A GI doesn't say "petrol". He says, "Gas her up." or, "Fill her up." They looked over at that Jeep, and two of the guys in the back were sitting up all straight and proper. They were Krauts. Americans don't sit in a Jeep like that! They sit leaning

back, halfway out with one foot on the dashboard! Wrong troops.

That's people back there behind your lines, mixed in with your group. They look like them and talk like them, but they are not there for anything but to serve themselves.

The first step in developing a unit is taking an oath. You step up, raise your hand, and swear to do this and that. Then you get a uniform, and you get a distinctive patch—1<sup>st</sup> Cavalry, 1<sup>st</sup> Airborne, 86<sup>th</sup> Infantry, etc. You get marked. If you are a real soldier of the cross, you're a marked man. Then there are drills. That's street preaching, passing out tracts, etc.

A real military must have confidence and pride in his unit. If not, the unit has no cohesion—the unit won't stick together in combat. Now I am not talking about you fighting the brethren. I'm talking about you recognizing sin in yourself and fighting it day by day. I'm talking about you recognizing sin in the world and avoiding it day by day. I'm talking about you recognizing the world system as your enemy and going against it day by day. I'm talking about that kind of a fight. I'm talking about you fighting in order to please your Commander.

A German told me one time that at El Alamein, every man was his own general. I know what he meant by that. He meant that the battle was so torn and scattered that every guy had to make decisions on the spot. He had no orders.

The Yankees mostly credited Colonel Joshua Chamberlain for the

victory at Gettysburg. He was stuck with around 320 men of the 20<sup>th</sup> Maine on Little Round Top. A stupid Yankee General from New York had his artillery down in the valley, on the low ground when it should have been up on the hill. Chamberlain secured Little Round Top, and when the Southerners charged up, he ordered a bayonet charge down the hill. He secured that flank, and that's why Lee had to finally wind up going through the center. He couldn't get around the flank. That's the work of one man, with 320 men. The work is done by a few faithful men.

Alright, the next lesson is in verses 5-7. The Lord said, "**...By the three hundred men that lapped will I save you...**" (vs. 5). What he is looking for here is alertness. Do you see what he did there? The guy that gets his drink by sticking his head down in the water is interested in fighting nothing! The guy that keeps his head up and laps the water out of his hand is looking for the attack. What he wants is alertness. God wants a man that's not just interested in feeding his gut. He's interested in a man that's wide awake.

There's a case in the Old Testament where Elisha calls in Joash, the king. Elisha says, "I'm dying, but before I die, get a bow and arrow." Joash got a bow and arrow, and Elisha said, "Now go open the window." He opens the window, and Elisha says, "Now place an arrow in the bow." Then Elisha puts his hand on the king's hand and has him shoot. Then

he says to the king, "**The arrow of the LORD'S deliverance, and the arrow of deliverance from Syria**" (2 Kings 13:17).

**"And he said, Take the arrows. And he took them. And he said unto the king of Israel, Smite upon the ground. And he smote thrice, and stayed"** (2 Kings 13:18).

Elisha said, "Why did you do that? You only hit it three times. Now you are only going to beat the Syrians three times. If you had hit it a dozen times, you'd of beaten them until you whipped them." Joash said, "Well, how was I supposed to know that?". "Because I said, 'The Lord's arrow of deliverance from Syria.' You weren't listening." The guy was asleep!

The Lord is looking for alertness. If your first concern is image, security, and recognition, you're in the wrong outfit. You need a man that is wide awake.

Back in 1914, there was a massive German attack that killed a division. The attack went clear back in the rear areas back about a mile behind the lines and killed a lot of the commanders. The British general had already pulled back his howitzers to cover the retreat. (Howitzers look like oversized mortars. They don't have a long barrel like a cannon, but they can throw some dirty stuff!) The 2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion, Englishmen from the Worcestershire Regiment, under Major E. B. Hankey, was ordered to counter-attack the Germans at Gheluvelt. They had about 370 men and were to attack a whole German

division. Major Hankey ordered the attack, and they went through and routed an entire German division. Hankey didn't even have a battalion with him! The Germans expected everyone to be still running away from them, and Hankey counter-attacked. He found the Germans looking for water and food and looting the houses. They weren't awake, and he caught the whole bunch of them by surprise.

Audie Murphy, a Texas boy, was 5' 5", and weighed about 130 lbs. He was commander of B Company, and on January 26, 1945, they were attacked by six tanks and waves of infantry. Murphy had his men retreat and stayed behind to direct artillery fire. He found a tank destroyer that was on fire. He climbed on top of it and began firing the .50 caliber machine gun. With Germans on three sides of him, he held them off for something like an hour. They couldn't see him because of the smoke coming off the tank destroyer. They gave him the Medal of Honor. He was wounded in the leg, and he refused first aid and led a counter-attack. That boy was alert—wide awake, quick, ready to go!

Finally, I want to say this; all these people needed was God's power.

**“And the LORD said unto Gideon, The people that are with thee are too many for me to give the Midianites into their hands, lest Israel vaunt themselves against me, saying, Mine own hand hath saved me”** (Judg. 7:2).

God fixed it so that when they got the victory, they would have to say that God did it. You find this bunch that says that they did it. It's all show and all props—it isn't real. This country is filled with them. They're taking credit for the work. God will fix it so this bunch can't get the credit.

If I'd been Gideon, I would have quit right on the spot. I wouldn't have had the faith to do what he did. What did they get for equipment? They got pitchers, lamps, and trumpets. What? No M-16s? No M-14s? No mortars, anti-tank guns, or grenades? Lamps, pitchers, and trumpets! What are you going to do? Play them a tune and then whack them on the head with a jug? I mean, you talk about a mess, man!

The Lord says, “We're not going to use any of these methods.”

**“But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty”** (1 Cor. 1:27).

Let me tell you the modern way to carry on the combat. You get up a big bond program, and you borrow \$150,000. Then, you send people all around the country to drum up money for you. Never preach anything negative; always preach everything that is sweet and kind. Always make them feel like they are really important so they can really appreciate themselves. That's how you do it. The Lord says, “Lamps, pitchers, trumpets.” That's all—Brass, pottery, and fire.

Do you know what I have tried to do for 50 years? I have tried to set up a work where the only things I relied on were prayer and that Book. Amen! Nothing else was used—there weren't any gimmicks. There weren't any bonds, funds drives, or Alumni associations. All my life as a Christian, I have tried to do the work with just two resources, that Book and the Lord—PERIOD! I imagine that's why we're not a big church. I know how to build a big church—you bet your life I do. Just compromise and cut corners. Bless God; we're just NOT going to do it!

On October 2, 1918, the 77<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division, under Major Charles Whittlesey, took part in the Meuse-Argonne Offensive. They were 200 yards into a German division. They were called the "Lost Battalion". You don't want ever to get caught 200 yards behind the line in a German division—it's just not a nice place to be! They were called upon to surrender, but they didn't do it. They were getting decimated by the Germans and by "friendly" artillery fire. They had no water and no food. They got through, though only 194 were left standing. They had what you call a "fighting spirit"—faithful unto death.

The Battle of Waterloo was fought on June 18, 1815. There was a farm up on the left flank of the Englishmen called the Hougomont Farm. During the battle, Field Marshal Ney kept telling Napoleon, "I think you better attack now." When Napoleon refused, Marshal Ney said, "But emperor,

don't you think under the circumstances...". Napoleon said, "Circumstances—what are circumstances? I make circumstances." That was a dumb thing to say! He lost his shirt! Napoleon ended up running for his life, with Marshall Ney, riding around the battlefield with saber slashes all over his boots and powder burns on his face, saying, "Come and see how a marshal of France dies!"

In Russia, when the counter-attack finally came through after Stalingrad, they gave the Germans a pretty rough beating. There is one case where a young Lieutenant was about 20 years old. His "Eighty-Eight" was out of commission, and the gun crew all dead—all 6 of them. He picked up their rifles, the ones he could use, and fired all their ammo. After he had fired all the rifle ammo, he fired with his Luger until that was ammo gone. When the Russians came, he was sitting there with his arm in a sling and frozen blood all over him and all his ammo gone. They told him "Hände hoch" (hands up). And do you know what that kid did? He stood up and walked right up to them and spit on them. You say, "Did they kill him?". Yeah, they killed him. You say, "That was a dumb thing to do." I don't know. Maybe he would have suffered worse as a prisoner, but man, what a gesture! When the world comes at you and tells you to surrender—spit on the world! Amen! Die hard, die hard!

**"Watch ye, stand fast in the faith, quit you like men, be strong" (1 Cor. 16:7).**

told him to.

In 1988, the old murdering reprobate led his people to accept the UN Partition plan that separated a new country from Israel that they named "Palestine". The only other two passages where the word appears in the KJV (Exod. 15:14 and Isa. 14:29-31), are both prophecies of a land that the Lord Jesus Christ will destroy and dissolve at His second coming. That land is not called "Philistia", as the corrupt versions call it in all three places. The land that will be in place when the Lord returns to stomp it out will be called Palestine, exactly as prophesied by the KJV. The lying media (Fox, MSNBC, etc.) all use the Boss's name for the land today, unknowingly bowing to what was predicted by Moses over 3,500 years ago (Exod. 15:14), and Isaiah, over 2,700 years ago (Isa. 14:29), and Joel, at the very least, over 2,500 years ago (Joel 3:4).

In another example, since 2006, the United Nations has adopted almost as many resolutions against the one tiny nation of Israel, as it has against the rest of the world combined! Think about that fact for a minute. With all the genocides of North Korea, Rwanda, Afghanistan, Nigeria, Cambodia, Burundi, Zimbabwe, Iraq, Uganda, the Congo, Sri Lanka, Myanmar, Sudan, and all the Muslim terrorist killings over the years, the United Nations has seen fit to denounce Israel as much as all the others combined. The typical media-controlled mind continually talks about the "Palestinian refugees" as if it was something that dwarfs all other refugee problems of the world. As a matter of fact, to listen to the

lying media, one would think it was the ONLY refugee problem that ever took place.

When the Ottoman Empire was defeated in WWI, the League of Nations removed all ethnic Turks from Greece, and all ethnic Greeks from Turkey, forcing about two million people to become refugees from their homes. When England pulled out from their colonial rule over India in 1947, they created the country of Pakistan. Before the bloodshed was over, about seven million Muslims fled Hindu-dominated India for Muslim-dominated Pakistan, while almost the same number of Hindu refugees had to flee Pakistan for India. No news push about these fourteen million refugees?

Do United Nations resolutions flow out of New York, condemning the Syrians for causing four million refugees to suffer? Is there a good reason that the UN Resolution #194 (which asserts the unconditional right of return and compensation for the displaced Palestinians from Israel in 1948) does not exist for the fifty million refugees of Syria, Iraq, India, Pakistan, Sudan, etc.? When the Arabs attacked Israel in 1948 and again in 1967, did the UN stand up for the "human rights" of the over eight hundred thousand Jews that were forced from their homes in the surrounding Arab lands after the defeat?

Why the hatred for one small country by the rest of the world? Because the Boss declared it to be so. That one tiny nation has had to stand apart from all the other nations according to the prophecy of the KJV (and once again, only the KJV). In Numbers 23:9, the

 Boss says of Israel, "...lo, the people shall dwell alone, and shall not be reckoned among the nations." When you turn to the underlying corrupt readings, you are not told that the Jews must dwell alone, but instead, that they "do not consider themselves one of the nations" (NIV), or they "prefer to remain distinct" (Living), or Israel is "not reckoning itself among the nations" (RSV). In other words, they say that it is Israel that does not want to be among the nations, instead of it being the Lord that causes them to dwell alone.

After being voted in as the Prime Minister of Israel in 1969, Golda Meir spent brooding hours complaining about the international isolation of her country and her people, according to insiders. She once looked around the United Nations Assembly and said to herself, "we have no family here... Israel is entirely alone here, less than popular, and certainly misunderstood. All we have to fall back on is our own Zionist faith. But why should that be? Why? Why?" Without the Boss, she got no answers and died in that condition.

In 1977, Prime Minister Rabin had the misfortune to have to deal with the forked-tongued US President from Georgia, Jimmy Carter. In a public greeting, Carter told Rabin that Israel "must have defensible borders," and the "United States is deeply committed to the security and welfare of Israel," and that there is "no intention of our imposing upon your country any settlement that you feel might jeopardize your security." Then, behind closed doors with the lying peanut farmer and his drunk Irish Speaker of the House,

"Tipped Over" O'Neil, Rabin was told that he must give up land according to the Geneva Convention, and negotiate with the murderous Arafat and his PLO. O'Neil asked Rabin why he couldn't negotiate with the PLO like the USA

did with the Viet Cong. Rabin answered with his own questions, saying, "Mr. O'Neil...did the Vietcong refuse to recognize the existence of the United States? Was their basic program a Viet Cong Covenant denying America's right to exist?" Neither Jimmy nor the "Tipper" were able to deal with facts and truth, and a number of days later, Carter made a public push for the need of a Palestinian state. Why? Just ask the Boss.

Menachem Begin became the next Prime Minister of Israel that had to deal with Carter, and just before coming over for a special meeting with the Americans, he just happened to have Numbers 22-24 come up for his regular Saturday night home Bible study. When Numbers 23:9 came up for discussion, Begin read the verse and asked out loud, "Is it not a startlingly accurate prophecy of our Jewish people's experience in all of history?"

One of his Hebrew scholars then answered that the real meaning might be that it was a voluntary choice of the Jews that they dwell alone (which is what all the corrupt versions say). This guess was followed up by another scholar, a woman, who told Rabin that the Hebrew here was in the reflexive form and meant, "This is a people that does not reckon itself among the nations." Another professor then piped in with the idea that the reflexive form of the root word means "to conspire" and hence, should read, "Is a people that dwells alone and does not conspire against other nations."

Begin listened intently through all of this, but would not buy any of it. He came to the conclusion that there

can never be a separation of the Jewish nation from their faith, and that there can never be a Jewish people that is a state only. Therefore, taking the position of Dr. Yaakov Herzog, (and unknowingly the position of the KJV1611), Begin realized that if the Jews ever ceased to dwell alone, they would cease to exist. All this just happened to take place in his home, only a few days prior to his meeting with Carter in America.

When the meeting took place, Dr. Schmu'el Katz, who was Begin's adviser, told the Americans that Arafat's 1974 UN speech was a total lie when he claimed that the Palestinians lived and worked the land for the last few thousand years. The U. S. Secretary of State Cyrus Vance, showing his ignorance of the facts of history, replied that he didn't see anything wrong with Arafat's words. Katz read from Mark Twain's 1867 travel book called *Innocents Abroad*, showing the complete absence of villages and permanent dwellings across the desolate place, with nothing more than a few goat herders and Bedouin tents for miles and miles. Menachem Begin smiled and added some more facts to the story, and while Carter only got angrier, his National Security Adviser, Brzezinski, became sarcastic.

Now, why are all these Gentiles so full of animosity toward the Jewish people? Their four-thousand-year-old history shows a constant barrage of hatred and murderous intent heaped on them by the Gentile world. The Arab world surrounding them wants them dead because the Boss records this fact about them in

Genesis 16:12 **"...he will be a wild man...and he shall dwell in the presence of all his brethren."** The Lord created the Jews as a special people, and above all others (Deut. 7:6, **"...the Lord thy God hath chosen thee to be a special people unto himself, above all people that are upon the face of the earth"**), and the Gentiles instinctively know this.

The Jews have been hounded, harassed, and slaughtered by the Roman Catholic popes, and by Germany, Spain, France, England, Italy, and Russia, as well as the whole Arab world. At her beginning as a nation coming out of Egypt, the Lord told them that they **"shall be a peculiar treasure unto me above all people... and ye shall be unto me a kingdom of priests and an holy nation"** (Exod. 19:5-6).

Prime Minister Begin unknowingly followed what the Boss said about his people. They can never survive as a people separating their political nation from their faith. They exist as a people separated from the rest of the nations and dwell alone—by God's choice, not theirs. Israel is the only nation in the history of the world that has had the Lord God as their judge, lawgiver, and king (Isa. 33:22). From this setup, America split its government into three branches, the Judicial (Judge), the Legislative (Lawgiver), and the Executive (King). The glaring difference, however, is that the Lord God is not on our Supreme Court, nor has ever been present in the halls of our Congress, and most certainly has never sat in the Oval Office at the White House.

When the Lord Jesus Christ returns the second time to save the remnant of Israel and start over, it will be from Jerusalem as the capital of the millennial world. The Boss plays the tune, and the world still dances to it. The "scholars" do their best to attack and mutilate it, but the KJV1611 still stands, and always will.

Now, here we are in 2022, and the Boss has determined that the world will have to bow to a coming satanic christ, an imposter who imitates the true Christ, and causes **"all the world"** (Rev. 13:3) to wonder after the beast. This one world ruler, who is a **"vile person"**, **"shall come in peaceably, and obtain the kingdom by flatteries"** (Dan. 11:21). After receiving a deadly wound in an imitation of the death of Christ (Rev. 13:3), he will then resurrect from **"his own place"** (Acts 1:25) from the **"bottomless pit"** (Rev. 11:7), on the Passover feast (as Christ). All the armies of the nations will gather north of Jerusalem (Joel 3:2, Zech. 14:2) for a battle against the single nation of Israel, only to be devoured with the fire of the fierce jealousy of the Lord (Zeph. 3:8).

Over the last two years especially, we have seen the whole world fold like a card table, when the World Health Organization and the Center for Disease Control laid down some rules about a virus. The economies of

countries were strangled, and whole populations are now happily bowing to their new masters. A vaccine suddenly appeared out of thin air (which normally requires years and years of study, testing, and applications to the FDA), and folks rushed and waited in lines to get their shots, in spite of the lack of any facts from the medical community.

None of this scenario has anything to do with staying healthy, but everything to do with being controlled. The young people that get the virus recover without any medications at a rate of over 99%, yet the drug companies applied, and got approval to begin vaccinations of those between twelve and eighteen years old. Now, they are going after the little ones from five to twelve years old and will probably have a rushed FDA approval by the time you read this article.

Neighbors have turned each other in for walking outside without a mask, mothers have turned in their daughters for going to a church meeting, leading toward what the Boss predicted would come to pass in the last days before His coming, namely, that **“a man’s foes**

**shall be they of his own household”** (Matt. 10:36), and **“the brother shall deliver up the brother to death, and the father the child: and the children shall rise up against their parents, and cause them to be put to death”** (Matt. 10:21). The setup for the great tribulation and the time of Jacob’s trouble is getting into place very neatly, now requiring only the “man of sin” to show up and require his worship and his mark. This little virus is a warmup compared to what is coming.

The Christians have also folded very easily, without so much as a peep, for the most part, doing exactly what they are told, **“forsaking the assembling of themselves together”** (Heb. 10:25), all the while convincing themselves that they are showing concern for the health of their neighbors, yet never knocking on their doors to show concern for their eternal souls.

All of these events are orchestrated by the Boss, and the world must sing the tune. The entire assembly of the nations cannot break a single scripture of the KJV1611 (John 10:35), even as they are told ahead of time what they will do.

# A Holy Hatred

**“I hate vain thoughts: but thy law do I love”** (Psa. 119:113).

Before I believed the Bible, I thought there was wisdom in the phrase, “Keep an open mind.” Since creation, never has man’s mind been so dumped upon as by the dawn of the Information Age and the power of mass media. Life’s highway is now cluttered with billboard after billboard telling us to consider this or that and make a judgment on what will please you most. Advertising tries to create a need where there is no need.

**“Vanity of vanities, saith the Preacher, vanity of vanities; all is vanity”** (Eccl. 1:2).

The mind of a Christian is, in these last days, a battlefield like no other. Corruption in our society has become so pervasive only a massive judgment from Heaven can halt the cancer. This happened once, and it will shortly have to happen again. Judgment is long overdue.

**“And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that EVERY IMAGINATION OF THE THOUGHTS OF HIS HEART WAS ONLY EVIL CONTINUALLY”** (Gen. 6:5).

John says, **“and the whole world lieth in wickedness”** (1 John 5:19). Does the last-days church see this clearly? According to Revelation 3:17, no, because the Holy Spirit says that church is blind. There is a mental health crisis today in our population, and many who come to Christ in adulthood bring wounded psyches to their new life in the faith. God’s proven antibiotic for mental

turmoil will always be His word.

**“Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusted in thee”** (Isa. 26:3).

For 2022, the spirit of confusion will gain momentum because the words of God have lost their influence even among the saved. Jesus once said of his own, **“This people draweth nigh unto me with their mouth, and honoureth me with their lips; but their heart is far from me”** (Matt. 15:8). Here’s the prototype of the Laodicean assembly in 587 B.C.

**“And they come unto thee (the prophet) as the people cometh and they sit before thee as my people, and they hear thy words, BUT THEY WILL NOT DO THEM: for with their mouth they shew much love, but their heart goeth after their covetousness”** (Ezek. 33:31).

So, what do we have today? **“Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, AND HAVE NEED OF NOTHING...”** (Rev. 3:17). Imagine telling the Lord, “I’m O.K., so what do I need from you?”. What arrogance, what sinful haughtiness! How much longer can the church of Jesus Christ remain here if it is without saltiness?

What goes on inside the minds of God’s people? No doubt, it is the will of God that our thought life be sanctified by the word of God. Apart from the word of God, a believer does not know how the thought life is acted upon by either the spirit of God, the spirit of the devil, or his or her own spirit. God’s word is an X-ray machine, and no proper diagnosis

of our spiritual health can be made without it.

**“For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, AND IS A DISCERNER OF THE THOUGHTS AND INTENTS OF THE HEART”** (Heb. 4:12).

God’s word performs like a super fine air conditioning filter removing the particles not visible to our own eyes. It has been given to us for our life’s journey here and never needs to be replaced. How can a saint expect to filter out what television, smartphones, the internet, and mass media pour into the thought life without a good grasp of the scriptures?

**“My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge”** (Hos. 4:6).

David said he hated vain thoughts, and he did not have to contend with what technology has given us today. He fought the same mental battles all believers experience. His eyes gazed upon Bathsheba, and all that he knew from the scriptures and his own personal walk with the God of Israel went flying from his mind, and you know the rest. The Laodicean believers said that they had need of nothing. Obviously, their spiritual eyes were infected. Modern Bible versions and wimpy “Love Gospel” preaching do that. What they needed most was a holy hatred of what they allowed to pass in and out of their minds. Disciplining the thought life for a Christian is the same as deep

breathing exercises for a swimmer. Our society has become a godless, filthy septic tank, and there are now many ways to slip and fall into it.

**“For Demas hath forsaken me, having loved this present world”** (2 Tim. 4:10).

Paul presented a battle plan to the Philippian believers in verse 8 of chapter 4. I’m sure he knew a lot about what it took to keep the mind clean and the heart ruled by the peace of God. There is a peace that passeth all understanding available to all God’s saints, but few seem to be finding it today. Look at the turmoil and division in the body of Christ over the Covid injection issue. You would think that your view on this issue, whether pro or con, will come up at the Judgment Seat of Christ. Is this how the church is to salt the society around it by attacking one another over this issue like the rest of the population is doing?

**“Behold, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that YE SHOULD EARNESTLY CONTEND FOR THE FAITH WHICH WAS ONCE DELIVERED UNTO THE SAINTS”** (Jude 3).

Satan would have God’s people leave off the war for souls and fight among themselves over an issue that has elevated the internet to a place where it competes with the Holy Spirit for the attention of the saints. This is really sad. We are told to contend for the faith in a book that appears just before Revelation

and the taking out of the body of Christ. The issue is snatching souls from Hell. Has the passion for that endeavor been replaced by a passion to judge the merits or lack thereof for getting vaccinated? If a believer gets sick and dies from the shot or from not getting a shot—does not the Lord do all things well? Didn't Paul write that **"to die is gain"** (Phil. 1:21)? Do you think that's something the Christians of today want preached on? Not when they say they have need of nothing.

My mind can be made to fear either by God or the devil. I have to determine where that fear is coming from and how it is to be dealt with. Our world is filled with danger. We are, at times, a step away from death. As a New Yorker taking the subway each weekday from Brooklyn to my office in lower Manhattan, I had to have a defensive posture always. You never knew what would develop in a moment and cause you to fear. Could I quit work and stay home? Then who pays the bills for a wife and four children? Scripture can tame any fear, real or imagined. Paul showed me the way in Acts 20:24: **"But none of these things move me, neither count I my life dear unto myself..."** Try preaching that to the "Selfie" generation of today. When you know what your purpose is and who it is that you are to serve, you contend for what matters.

A materialistic, consumer-oriented society is the fruit of a mindset inundated by vain thoughts continually. Its effect upon the body of Christ has been devastating.

Could those who took up the cross centuries ago have envisioned a day when this was written concerning the last-days church?

**"Because thou sayest, I am rich and increased with goods"** (Rev. 3:17).

What is vain is spiritually useless. Growing in the grace and knowledge of Jesus Christ is an impossibility where the mind is given over to vanity. Notice the word abhor rather than hate in Romans 12:9. Holiness produces an abhorrence toward all that steals from the glory of God. Man and his achievements have been so lifted up in these last days that the need to seek after God is no longer a factor in the thought life of almost all Americans. Vanity rejects the idea of man's helplessness. We like to see ourselves as adequate for every challenge that confronts us. That is why you hear after a loss of some kind, "Boston Strong" or "New York Strong", etc.

**"The fear of the LORD is to hate evil: pride, and arrogance, and the evil way, and THE FROWARD MOUTH, do I hate"** (Prov. 8:13).

We are in a battle until death or the rapture (Titus 2:13), whichever comes first. The battlefield, our minds, are littered with the scars of war. Paul says in 2 Corinthians 10:4 that the weapons of our warfare are not carnal. What are those weapons? For me, they are prayer, scripture, and pleading the blood of Jesus Christ to beat back an artillery barrage from the enemy. Without the use of these weapons, how can I effectively perform what

I'm told to do in 2 Corinthians 10:5? Bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ is wishful thinking and nothing more without this holy fear of God standing watch at the gate of your mind.

Sin and the memories connected with it act upon our thought life like the ocean tide going in and out. It is a motion in our flesh that Paul references in Romans 7:5. **“For when we were in the flesh, the motions of sins, which were by the law, did work in our members to bring forth fruit unto death.”**

The motion of sin was not shut down by receiving the new birth. Sin can lose some of its power immediately at one's conversion, but practically, it is far from defeated. At 32, I was recently saved and rejoicing in what the Lord had done for me. I had no idea that the ways of Egypt and the love of pleasure had such a hold on my thought life. This, I discovered when reading my Bible and trying to memorize scripture. It was a most unpleasant revelation.

What many find out when they come to the Lord later in life is that the law of inertia is in full play. It's like a vehicle speeding along and hitting a concrete wall. All forward motion ceases except that of your body. Conversion immediately translates you from the kingdom of darkness to the kingdom of light. It is the greatest event in the life of any sinner, small or great. A crash, a wreck has saved your life and not taken it. However, the motion of sin in you mentioned in Romans 7:5 has not ceased.

Seat belts are a great thing. They

keep the body from hurling through the windshield in many wrecks. The Holy Spirit acts in such a way, and the strength of His hold upon you will be determined in large measure by how quickly your mind is renewed by the power of the scripture. Sin's motion in me was like swimming against a powerful wave moving towards the shore, wanting me to stay in Egypt in my thought life. You fight and swim, or you drown. Scripture which cannot lie says, **“I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me”** (Phil. 4:13). Well, either you can or you can't. No Christian need be a victim and a trophy for the devil if the word of God is constantly used to put down vain thoughts and all high things standing against the knowledge of a holy God.

In 2022, the pressure to think as a lost person thinks will intensify. Believers will be told they have rights and that they are to stand for those rights. Hopefully, the Lord will remind His people that they are citizens of Heaven and this world is not their home. The U.S. Constitution and the Bill of Rights are not in our *King James Bible*. We have to contend for the faith. I don't see anywhere in the gospels where Jesus involved Himself in political issues or showed antagonism toward Roman rule. It's vain to think your rights as a U.S. citizen cannot be taken away. If the right set of circumstances comes along, and they might, your rights will disappear with the declaration of a national state of emergency. As America continues to push away the Holy

## THE CREED OF THE ALEXANDRIAN CULT

1. There is **no final authority** but God.
2. Since God is a Spirit, there is **no final authority** that can be seen, heard, read, felt, or handled.
3. Since all books are material, there is **no book on this earth that is the final and absolute authority** on what is right and what is wrong, what constitutes truth and what constitutes error.
4. There **WAS** a series of writings one time which, **IF** they had all been put into a **BOOK** as soon as they were written the first time, **WOULD HAVE** constituted an infallible and final authority by which to judge truth and error.
5. However, this series of writings was lost, and the God who inspired them was **unable to preserve their content** through Bible-believing Christians at Antioch (Syria), where the first Bible teachers were (Acts 13:1), and where the first missionary trip originated (Acts 13:1-52), and where the word "*Christian*" originated (Acts 11:26).
6. So God chose to **ALMOST** preserve them through Gnostics and philosophers from Alexandria, Egypt, even though God called His Son **OUT** of Egypt (Matthew 2), Jacob **OUT** of Egypt (Genesis 49), Israel **OUT** of Egypt (Exodus 15), and Joseph's bones **OUT** of Egypt (Exodus 13).
7. So there are two streams of Bibles. The most accurate—though, of course, there is **no final, absolute authority** for determining truth and error; it is a matter of "preference"—are the Egyptian translations from Alexandria, Egypt, which are "almost the originals," although not quite.
8. The most **inaccurate translations** were those that brought about the German Reformation (Luther, Zwingli, Boehler, Zinzendorf, Spener, et al.) and the worldwide missionary movement of the English-speaking people: the Bible that Sunday, Torrey, Moody, Finney, Spurgeon, Whitefield, Wesley, and Chapman used.
9. But we can "tolerate" these if those who believe in them will "tolerate" US. After all, since there is **NO ABSOLUTE AND FINAL AUTHORITY** that anyone can read, teach, preach, or handle, the whole thing is a matter of "PREFERENCE." You may prefer what you prefer, and we will prefer what we prefer. Let us live in peace, and if we cannot agree on anything or everything, let us all agree on one thing: **THERE IS NO FINAL, ABSOLUTE, WRITTEN AUTHORITY OF GOD ANYWHERE ON THIS EARTH.**

This is the Creed of the Alexandrian Cult.
